Plan for Metech return to a 75% material turnover rate:

To immediately address the non-compliance issue of exceeding the time limit on the storage CRT glass, Metech has Prepaid Glassico (TDA) for five shipments, equaling approximately 185,000 net pounds. The first and second of the five have shipped on August 21st and the 22nd for a combined weight of 74,817 pounds. The remaining three are scheduled for August 27th, 30th, and 31st. Completing these five shipments will ensure that there is not any glass that is not beyond August 31st, 2018.

To remain in compliance with the CRT storage limit, beginning September 1st, 2018, Metech Denver, will ship out a minimum of two loads of CRT glass each month, each shipment equaling approximately 37,000 net pounds. By the end of December 2018, the oldest glass should be from January 2018. A projected schedule (CRT Ship Projection) is included listing the CRT lot numbers and weights along with the ship by date.

An extrapolation of the current year data shows that we should reach a turnover rate of at least 90% with current operation not counting the additional shipments of CRT glass being made to make up for the lack of shipments between April 2018 and August 2018. A mass balance spreadsheet is also attached.
