The Porter Pet Parker is a plastic disc with a centered rotating snap hasp that can be attached to a pet's collar. As the hasp is short enough to keep your dog from "walking, running or lunging," the parker is meant to be used as a pet training and management tool – used to help a dog "recognize their boundaries, to keep convalescing dogs somewhat immobile, and to socialize new dogs." Though it keeps more rambunctious behavior at bay, the pet is still able to move comfortably around the diameter of the disc, standing, laying or sitting.

The parkers come in three sizes – 18, 24 or 30 inches in diameter – sized proportionally for the type of dog, and can help training for a impressive variety of issues, including "excessive playing, begging at the dinner table, chewing improper objects, separation anxiety, introduction of a new pet, grooming, housetraining, thievery, visiting the vet, barking, jumping up and traveling." One caveat offered by Aldergate, about the parker, "it is very important to only use a Porter Pet Parker with human supervision."

The CUDO water storage system is a “new approach to underground stormwater storage, infiltration, treatment, rainwater harvesting or other stormwater management needs.” The system is made up modular plastic cubes called CUDO, so named for “Cube d’eau,” which is French for “cube of water.”

The CUDO, made in the U.S. from injection-molded recycled polypropylene, incorporates an “arched design that adds structural integrity, increased water storage and enhanced access for inspection and maintenance.” Because the system is modular, it can be installed in all manner of configurations or levels, and projects using the system can receive “potential LEED new construction credits for sustainable sites, materials and re-use and water efficiency.”
