Overview

This NWRA white paper assists organizations in the waste and recycling industry to properly identify their NAICS codes for reporting purposes to various government agencies, some of which are Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA), Bureau of the Census, and other. In addition, knowing your codes will help the NWRA as it advances data collection of the industry.

Once identified, comparison with government produced data on your operations can be analyzed and used in business decisions.

Factors in Determining Your NAICS Code

- 1) Identify your organizations operations
- 2) Identify which operations are in separate locations or buildings
- 3) Find the NAICS code that best describes that operation
- 4) A key phrase in determining your code is "primarily engaged in"
- 5) If operations are located in the same building or on the same grounds, they can be combined into the NAICS code with the highest revenue.

Waste & Recycling Industry NAICS Codes

There are six industry codes that represent the *core operations* of the waste & recycling industry:

NAICS 562111 Solid Waste Collection
NAICS 562119 Other Waste Collection
NAICS 562212 Solid Waste Landfill
NAICS 562213 Solid Waste Combustors and Incinerators
NAICS 562219 Other Nonhazardous Waste Treatment and Disposal
NAICS 562920 Materials Recovery Facilities

The following most common codes (not exhaustive) represent *supportive operations*:

Definitions for the CORE OPERATIONS

NAICS 562111 Solid Waste Collection

This U.S. industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in one or more of the following: (1) collecting and/or hauling nonhazardous solid waste (i.e., garbage) within a local area; (2) operating nonhazardous solid waste transfer stations; and (3) collecting and/or hauling mixed recyclable materials within a local area.

562119 Other Waste Collection

This U.S. industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in collecting and/or hauling waste (except nonhazardous solid waste and hazardous waste) within a local area. Establishments engaged in brush or rubble removal services are included in this industry.

562212 Solid Waste Landfill

This U.S. industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in (1) operating landfills for the disposal of non-hazardous solid waste or (2) the combined activity of collecting and/or hauling nonhazardous waste materials within a local area and operating landfills for the disposal of nonhazardous solid waste. These establishments may produce byproducts, such as methane.

562213 Solid Waste Combustors and Incinerators

This U.S. industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in operating combustors and incinerators for the disposal of nonhazardous solid waste. These establishments may produce byproducts, such as electricity and steam.

562219 Other Nonhazardous Waste Treatment and Disposal

This U.S. industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in (1) operating nonhazardous waste treatment and disposal facilities (except landfills, combustors, incinerators and sewer systems or sewage treatment facilities) or (2) the combined activity of collecting and/or hauling of nonhazardous waste materials within a local area and operating waste treatment or disposal facilities (except landfills, combustors, incinerators and sewer systems, or sewage treatment facilities). Compost dumps are included in this industry.

562920 Materials Recovery Facilities

This industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in (1) operating facilities for separating and sorting recyclable materials from nonhazardous waste streams (i.e., garbage) and/or (2) operating facilities where commingled recyclable materials, such as paper, plastics, used beverage cans, and metals, are sorted into distinct categories.

There is one classification that causes difficulty among recycling operations. Which NAICS do you belong in NAICS 423930 (definition below) or NAICS 562920? Are your operations a MRF or a scrap recycler? Looking at the key phrase is "primarily engaged in," helps to determine the proper NAICS code. If the operation of the facility is primarily sorting of materials, then the operations are classified as a MRF, NACIS 562920. If the facility is primarily engaged is selling materials, meaning that little or no sorting is going on, then the operations are that of a scrap recycler, NAICS 423930.

423930 Recyclable Material Merchant Wholesalers

This industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in the merchant wholesale distribution of automotive scrap, industrial scrap, and other recyclable materials. Included in this industry are auto wreckers primarily engaged in dismantling motor vehicles for the purpose of wholesaling scrap.

Background on the NAICS Codes

The NAICS replaced the Standard Industry Classification (SIC) codes in 1997. Both sets of codes identify industries in America and assign a code number to them.

The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) is the standard used by Federal statistical agencies in classifying business establishments for the purpose of collecting, analyzing, and publishing statistical data related to the U.S. business economy.

NAICS was developed under the auspices of the Office of Management and Budget (OMB), and adopted in 1997 to replace the Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) system. SIC to NAICS Translation Table
