### PSI Chapter Posts 2020 Scholarship Application

**(Washington, DC)**—The **Paper Stock Industries (PSI) Chapter**, a national chapter of the Institute of Scrap Recycling Industries, Inc., has launched its **2020 academic scholarship program**, posting the scholarship requirements and new application at **[paperstockindustries.org/scholarships/apply](http://paperstockindustries.org/scholarships/apply)**. The PSI scholarship program provides funds to select students who are dependents of employees in the recycling divisions of PSI Chapter member companies. PSI plans to give **\$2,000 scholarships to nine students in 2020**, beating its previous record of eight scholarships a year given in 2018 and 2019.
