E-SCRAP REFINING COMPANY STREAMLINES PROCESS FROM SCRAP TO BULLION

(Raleigh, NC – April 10th, 2020) – Opening today, [Evotus, Inc.](http://evotusinc.com/), aims to simplify the process and understanding of the complexities of an ever-changing e-scrap stream, provide accurate pricing, and leverage the metals market in favor of suppliers. Founded by Derek Ramsell, after working several years in the Escrap industry, Evotus designed their recycling process with intent – ensuring all operating procedures are compliant to R2 and ISO standards and certifications, and provide a customer-centric focus with a personal refining “concierge”.

“When I originally started in e-scrap recycling, the payout was much less than I believed to be the actual value of the metal, and the time to get paid often took months,” says Founder & CEO Derek Ramsell. “It was a long, complicated process that required volume and was subjected to a variety of fees and uncertain final payment. As an e-scrap recycler, refiner and business architect, I identified the inefficiencies in the system and designed Evotus’ simplified and transparent process to better reflect the diverse and complex materials stream while collaborating with the recycling community to cut overseas shipping and positively impact e-waste management resources in the US.”

Evotus is at its core is a tech-based market trading company, that manages physical metals all the way through scrap buying, to refining, to purified metals sale. The Evotus process is based on data-metric analysis from three forms of metals analysis, which is then cross-referenced to real-time market prices, allowing recyclers to leverage the metals market against accurate, live-values specific to their load. The clean-tech recycling process ensues there is no burning or harmful emissions.

Understanding that cashflow is critical to recyclers, Evotus’ pricing is comprised of one simple price - no added fees, charges, or retained metals – and payment is based on verification, so suppliers always know what to expect. Fostering an environment of community and collaboration, Evotus’ works with suppliers to understand the materials and optimize value and can handle loads as small as 50lbs at their Raleigh, NC facility.
